Intern Position Description

Description:

The intern in this position will be responsible for a variety of assigned projects and research tasks that align with the mission of the Center for Health and Research Transformation (CHRT). These may include: health policy and social determinants of health analysis; data analysis; drafting of issue briefs or slides for presentations; or other support for policy or research projects.

Based at the University of Michigan, CHRT promotes the delivery of evidence-based healthcare, the improvement of population health, and the expansion of access to care. For further information about CHRT, refer to: www.chrt.org.

About the Position:

We seek an individual who is energetic, flexible, motivated and analytical, with interest and experience in health policy analysis and/or data analysis and at least one year of graduate experience in public policy or public health. This is a paid internship, 40 hours a week during the summer, with flexible start and end dates.

The following functions in the scope of possible internship responsibilities (all under supervision of CHRT Senior Analyst):

- Research, analyze and identify health policy issues related to health care access, cost, use and quality, health care reform and public health. Present or write results for broader policy audiences.
- Develop recommendations that address identified issues.
- Support health policy, data analytic or research projects.

Interns will also participate in professional development activities.

Qualifications for Preferred Intern Candidates:

- Obtaining Master's degree in public policy or public health with a focus on health policy.
- Knowledge of key health policy issues and recent health care reform proposals or legislation.
- Knowledge of healthcare data sources.
- Knowledge of or experience with health care research or methodologies.
- Excellent writing, organizational and interpersonal skills.
